



FEEDBACK EVERGREEN BERGVLIET AGM MONDAY, 5 SEPTEMBER 2016

The Evergreen Village Bergvliet's Annual General Meeting held on Monday, 5 September at 3pm was well attended by 70+ residents. It was proposed that the new management committee consists of eight members of which two will be representatives from the Managing Agent. The six management committee members voted onto the committee by residents to represent the village are John Bester, Donald Campbell, Elda Diana-Oliario, Joan Misplon, Herman Poelmann and David Walker and will hold office until the next Annual General Meeting.

One of the items discussed in the meeting was the improvement and renovation to the existing clubhouse. Arthur Case indicated that the proposals, as discussed with the Management Committee, for the further development of the two properties on Barn road were submitted to the city council and that feedback from council is expected towards the end of the year. The proposed development of the two properties include the development of thirteen new houses and twenty-three new apartments together with a new clubhouse when construction of the new units commences. A new clubhouse will take approximately three years to design, develop and construct.

It has been agreed that a solution must be found to improve and renovate the existing clubhouse and that the Management Committee will also be pressing the matter to ensure the developer provides an interim solution and that this receives a priority. The meeting ended on a positive note – so watch this space for further news!

Babylonstoren is a historic Cape Dutch farm that dates back to 1692. It boasts one of the best preserved farmyards in the Cape laid out over 3,5 hectares. The garden is divided into 15 sections that comprise fruit, vegetables, berries, bees for pollinating, indigenous plants, fragrant lawns, a prickly pear maze, ducks and chickens, and more. A secluded path runs along the stream where thousands of clivias grow in the shade of the wild olive trees, including the very special Mick Dower collection displayed in the Puff Adder.

After a stroll through the garden, enjoy an informal, picnic-style light lunch under the oak trees or grab a cup of tea and cake

We have two options available which include transport, entrance fee and a reserved lunch (R310) or no lunch (R170).

The lunch option is on a first come, first served basis, subject to availability at the restaurant.
