



WATER, WATER EVERYWHERE!

Capetonians will soon be permitted to increase their water usage from 50 litres to 70 litres per person per day. Deputy Mayor Ian Neilson made the announcement recently and stated that after a devastating drought, the province's dams are now at 68% of storage capacity due to good rainfall throughout the winter months. This is a significant improvement on the situation which prevailed at the end of the last winter, when they were at 38% capacity. The drought was so uncommon that it only has an estimated return period of 311 years, he said.

The water restrictions and the associated tariffs are thus to be conservatively lowered in the interim to Level 5 from 1 October 2018. This will bring tariff relief of between 26,6% and 70% per kilolitre of water, depending on the usage and tariff category.



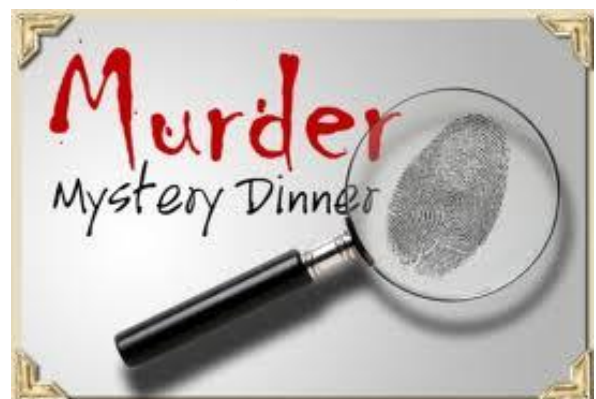
FLOWER DEMO PRIZEWINNERS

The move from the current Level 6B restrictions to Level 5 restrictions from October 2018 means an increase in personal water usage allocation. It also means a resetting of the overall city water-usage target from 450 million litres per day to 500 million litres per day and lowering of tariffs to Level 5.

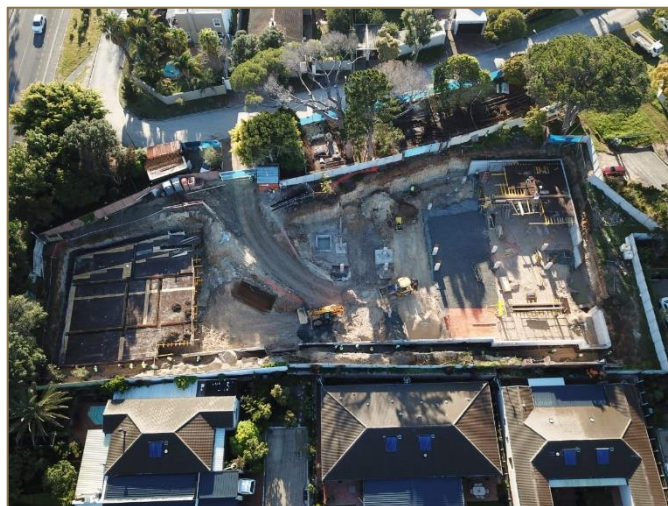
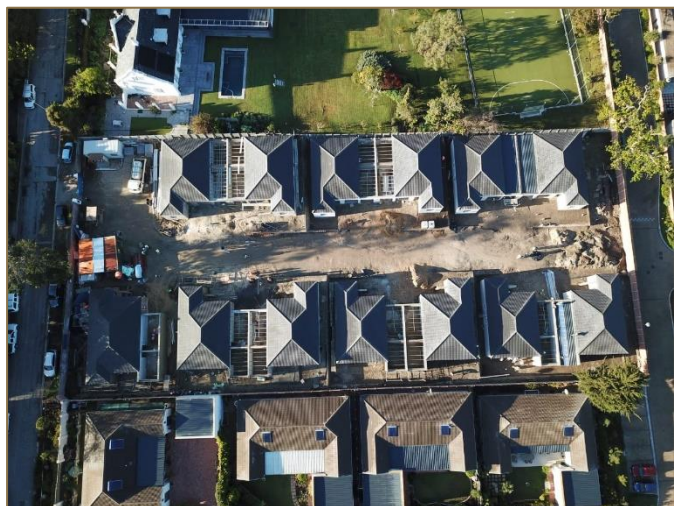

UPDATE ON DEVELOPMENT OF BARN ROAD & STARKE ROAD

The house development in Barn Road (below left) is coming along quite well with all brickwork, plasterwork and roofs complete on all thirteen units. Internal finishes on ceilings, tiling, joinery and painting are underway. Handover is on track for November.

The retaining wall in the basement of the apartments is almost complete and the surface bed is halfway done. The first section of the ground floor concrete slab was cast last week. This will be followed by the next section of the basement surface bed and ground floor concrete slab which will be cast in mid-September (aerial view bottom right).
