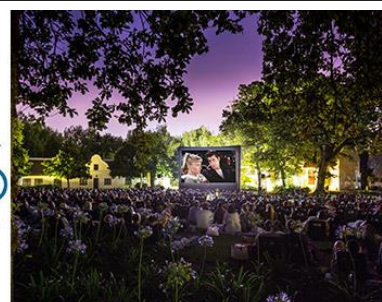
Join us for a magical night of summertime carol-singing under the stars in the Sculpture Garden!
