# BOARD OF HEALTHCARE FUNDERS (BHF) AND PRACTICE CODE NUMBERING SYSTEM (PCNS)

#### **BACKGROUND**

BHF is the representative organization which medical schemes may voluntarily belong to.

#### Registration with BHF

## BHF'S Decision not to issue practice numbers

- BHF has stopped allocating PCNS numbers to Agencies in 2012, allegedly, at the bidding of the Department of Health.
- Regulation 1 of the Medical Schemes Act no 131 1998 defines it as "the number allocated to a supplier
  of a relevant health service as a practice number, as an organization or body approved by the Medical
  Schemes (CMS)".
- It is in terms of this provision that CMS has tasked BHF with the responsibility of allotting practice numbers to supplier Health Services.
- The position stands, until reversed by a competent court or by the appeals Board of the Council for Medical Schemes.

**Evergreen Health**, established in 2018 has partnered with other Healthcare organizations, enabling residents to claim medical services directly from their Medical Aid Funder if Pre-Authorized.

### Process:

- Contact your Evergreen Health Clinic to discuss the service required. We will advise on a case-by-case basis depending on our partnership arrangements and your medical aid.
- Evergreen Health or the medical service provider would apply for authorization from your medical aid e.g., Wound Care.
- We would require a motivation letter from your doctor in some cases, motivating the services if required over time.
- Once authorized, Evergreen Health would then deliver the services required, including updating the medical aid, and manage extended authorization when needed.

#### Frail Care:

# Legislative Requirements: Licensed with the Department of Social Development

- Frail Care or any kind of assisted living, is considered a social welfare responsibility.
- Closed Medical schemes (e.g., Anglo Gold/ Profmed and Bankmed) may assist in monthly contributions, but the benefits are only for "medically related frail-care services" which means they would only contribute for recovering from an illness, injury or surgery.
- While medical aid schemes may not cover accommodation and care in a Care Centre for frail care or memory care, any chronic medication, visits by a doctor, as well as the cost of various appliances, may still be paid by the scheme in line with the particular package benefits.
- Open medical aids do not contribute towards frail care.
- Post-Op Care/ Rehabilitative Care (Stroke or Accident), such short-term help could be covered by medical aid, but cost for longer term accommodation in a Frail Care Facility is rare.
