

<u>Next "Team Evergreen" event – Parkrun Saturday 27th May 2017 @ 8am</u>

<u>General news</u> – There are a few of us who are now doing a Parkrun whenever we can on Saturday mornings either at Lonehill Park or Bryanston Riverside Park. Those who did the Lonehill Parkrun last Saturday achieved some memorable milestones.

Dave Nesbitt ran his 43rd Parkrun in a Personal Beat (PB) time- 27mins 12secs Basil Bolt ran his 3rd in a PB of 32mins 19secs

Hennie du Preez walked his 5^{th} at Lonehill and had a PB of $48ins 45sec - 1^{st}$ time under 50mins at Lonehill.

Val & Bob took a stroll in the park in 56mins 45secs, 3mins slower than last time!! I completed my 30^{th} Parkrun – 20 more for that red shirt.

I am not sure how Royston, Helen & Gerd did at Bryanston as I was unable to attend the social evening on Wednesday. However, the previous Saturday Gerd achieved a PB of 46mins 16secs, which I think is 3mins faster than his previous PB. Well done Gerd.
