Dear fellow Residents,

Cedar Road - Road Widening Update (taken from the Dainfern Newsletter)

The programme for the next 2 weeks (4th Sept to 18th Sept) is as follows:

- All preparation work between Uranium and Stinkwood Close (opp. Life Hospital Entrance) on the righthand side will be complete this week and the final layer will be constructed early next week.
- Next week Wednesday we will start asphalt between Valley (Broadacres Shopping entrance) and Frederick Roads. Note that Lombardy Road will be closed for periods, during Wednesday and Thursday.
- By Monday the 18 Sept, we should have traffic flow from Stinkwood to Valley Road contra flow on the right-hand side and Uranium to Stinkwood a double carriageway both sides.

The Uranium intersection will be repaired during the same period. The damage to the road is due to a new product we were instructed to test, by the consulting engineers and manufacturers. But as everyone can see this was not a successful experiment. We expect completion of both carriageways on Cedar road by end November.
