The Phelophepa ('Good Clean Health') Trains of Hope are two unique trains that operate as mobile healthcare hospitals, bringing much needed medical and educational services to impoverished rural areas of South Africa.



With over 40 permanent staff and numerous volunteers, the trains are more than a mobile hospital, they provided out-reach and educational programmes and have thus far reached 23.5 million people since they rolled out in 1994, which makes them the world's biggest mobile clinic! Phelophepa provides a simple, one-stop service for its patients everything a traveling hospital requires and the health care education outreach, ensures continued care once the train has departed.

The Phelophepa Trains now consist of six on-board operational Clinics: The Health Clinic, The Roche Pharmacy Clinic, The Educational Clinic, The Dental Clinic, The Eye Clinic and the Psychology Clinic.
