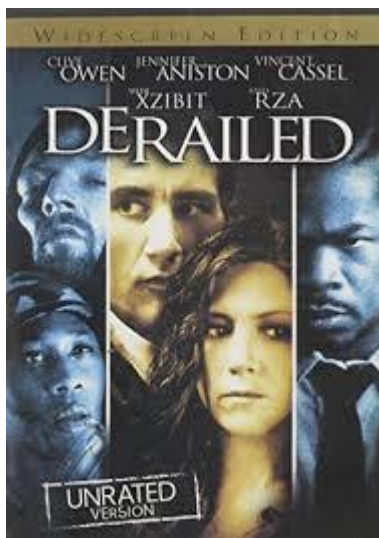
Being a communication to residents about Thursday's Movie
