

Modderfontein Parkrun Report and results - 3 February 2018

A new venue and a new experience as we walked around an open slightly sloped field through some of the numerous dynamite bunkers that were built to store the dynamite manufactured in the area at the height of the mining era. 10 Regulars set out to do the above and were surprised at the large turnout with 1202 finishers. It took us 30 minutes to get there and another 15 minutes to park, arriving 10 minutes before the start. The course was mainly along fairly bumpy grass tracks (speed humps?) and on old abandon roads full of pot holes. There was a large dam nearby with an abundance of bird life.

The organisers now scan your bar code cards before the start in an attempt to stop entrants from cheating and only doing the last short distance to claim their vitality points. If you do not have your bar code card scanned before the start you will not receive the results. I can't believe that people are cheating and appeal to Team Evergreen members who do not complete the full course, NOT to go through the finish tunnel at the end.

With so many entrants the start was a bit chaotic with everyone having to squeeze onto a grass track about 15 meters wide. This made it very difficult to pass others and it took about 1km 700m for the field to spread out and make passing easier. Manfred set off jogging as usual while Ron did his 700m dash once again. When Bob and I passed him after a short while, he said that his race was now over. Bob walked with me but said that I was walking faster than he could as he had to jog at times to keep up. However he put in a little jog at the finish to beat me by 3secs.

As mentioned, the course meandered up and down a very gentle slopping open field which enabled us to see others in front of us but we did not see Manfred. However if we looked far enough back we could see where Ron was. He did manage to finish 4th ahead of Norma again. He said afterwards that there were not enough down hills for him to do his now traditional 700m dashes He was followed by Kate who finished in 49mins 16secs, just 20secs slower than her PB. She bragged at. he finish that she had beaten Norma, who finished about 1 minute behind her in one of her better times recently. Gerd was the perfect gentleman again and finished with Norma.

Andy, still walking in his hiking boots, failed by just 4secs to beat his PB, but this time he was nearly a minute behind Norma. Dennis said that Cynthia had to stop to tie her shoe laces which took quite a while. Well done to everyone and once again our Team Evergreen t-shirts were noticed. Norma was still wearing her "Red 50 Parkrun" t-shirt as she had not yet received her "Black 100 Parkrun" t-shirt.
