- 3. <u>Planters and shrubberies around new LFC (Life style centre):</u> Project successfully completed at short notice.

- Irrigation to village and Frederick Road pavements: Comprehensive survey conducted, many short comings identified and most have been corrected. Rest will be attended to.
- **6.** <u>Bulrushes and Algae:</u> All bulrushes cleared from bridge pond, and good progress made in top pond. Algae still a problem.

3 MAJOR ACTIVITIES AT THE PRESENT

- 1. <u>Irrigation from borehole:</u> Borehole drilled in August 2017 but not yet operating. Detailed proposals prepared and submitted to Cape Town. Can only proceed with following after borehole and significant part of irrigation commissioned.
- 2. Developing shrubbery on new berm.
- 3. Developing shrubberies next to future Boule court and feature pond:
