Tape Aids is funded by donations and manned mainly by volunteers who read and produce the Audiobooks. It was an eye-opener to hear of the expertise, time and attention that is required to produce these books. Originally the audio books were recorded on tapes but now CDs are used which can be played on CD or DVD players and computers, provided they are MP3 compatible. MP3 apparently is able to condense the data to such an extent that a whole book of approx. 4-500 pages can fit on one CD disc. Andrew then read us an amusing short story — with all the appropriate voices and actions. It was great fun and a relaxing way to end the morning.
