Good day

Once again we are delighted to be the beneficiary of your generous Mandela Day 2018 collection of groceries.

Thank you so much for the wonderful array of staple foods that you donated which will be distributed amongst the hungry and sick people Fr Michael assists in the informal settlements of Video near Muldersdrift and Drummond on the way to Lanseria Airport. A portion of the tinned goods will be kept to add to our Christmas parcels.

We have made up 12 family parcels consisting of mealie meal or rice, dry beans, soup, sugar, tea or coffee and long life milk to which we have added soya mince that was donated by Cosmo City Secondary 1 school left over from their feeding scheme at the end of Term 2. This will put food on tables and into hungry tummies. Bless you all.

We also run our Thursday soup kitchens held at the Anglican Church in Cosmo City where any hungry people are welcomed. Currently 33 regular adults and 15 preschool children, more in the school holidays. Soup is made by volunteers and delivered frozen to All Saints, we then heat and distribute with bread donated by Spar Fourways Gardens and Pick n Pay at The Buzz.

We have also begun a reading club for the children in the school holidays using wonderful stories in the free Nalibali newspapers. These are printed in both English and Zulu with delightful illustrations and each issue has 3 stories catering for different age groups.

A special thank you to Roy Martin, Village Manager at Evergreen, Judy for their co-ordination and efforts and to Talfryn Davies for assisting with transport .
