You would surely have noticed that the top pond's spillway is being lowered.

19 new bank branches where you can get your South African smart ID and passport in 2020

The Department of Home Affairs (DHA) will roll out Smart ID and Passport facilities to several more bank branches in 2020.

The DHA launched Smart ID cards in 2013. These cards are a modern alternative to green ID books - which will eventually be phased out - and offer automated identity verification.

The process saves citizens the trouble of waiting in long queues at a Home Affairs office, where this type of task can be more time-consuming.

Currently, the E-Home Affairs branches are available at 16 bank locations across the country, most of which are in Gauteng. Now they have confirmed that 19 new locations will be added in the coming months.

The branches where the service will be rolled out are Rosebank Mall, Menlyn Maine, Key West, Claremont, Stellenbosch, Waterfall Mall, Woodlands, Pinetown, Fourways Mall, and Randburg.

FNB Points of Presence CEO Lee-Anne van Zyl confirmed that the bank was expanding the service to more branches across the country in 2020.

Nedbank said it will extend E-Home Affairs services to another four branches in 2020

Standard Bank spokesperson Ross Linstrom said the bank will open five more branches which offer SmartID and Passport services.

Below are the confirmed upcoming bank branches, as well as the bank branches that currently offer Smart ID card and Passport services.

<u>Grey domes on street poles across Joburg - The latest crime-fighting tools</u>



If you have driven around our area and Johannesburg recently, you might have noticed a significant number of grey domes mounted on poles around the city.

These fixtures are security installations deployed by Vumacam, which aims to crack down on crime in Johannesburg by effectively tracking vehicles and helping security companies to facilitate arrests.

"The cameras have most often been commissioned on request by a security company and placed in locations determined, in conjunction with the security company, to provide optimal camera coverage," the company said.

"LPR (Licence Plate Recognition) and overview cameras are installed in various configurations on our poles which are connected to our dome structures," Vumacam said.

These LPR cameras capture each licence plate it sees and references it against the vehicle of interest database, checking if it has been involved in any criminal activity.

If the camera algorithms pick up something strange, such as a licence plate linked to a crime, the security companies that rent the data will receive an alert in their control room and can react in real-time "480 car registrations per minute can be scanned and matched to the police database for stolen vehicles," Vumacam said.

In some areas, Vumacam has planted poles which are not yet camera-ready due to the lack of a fibre or power connection.

"Cameras are only installed once a vetted entity has subscribed to that particular pole location," Vumacam said.

"A pole and dome with cameras attached means that the pole is live and footage is being monitored." Vumacam said its clients have noted a sharp decrease in crime since the cameras became operational.

"In the City of Joburg, one of our clients, a security company, is monitoring only 150 Vumacams and over the course of only one month they responded to 20 Licence Plate Recognition alerts," Vumacam said.

"These resulted in 33 arrests by the SAPS; 12 stolen vehicles recovered; the drivers of nine of these vehicles linked to various other crimes were apprehended."

It added that since the cameras were implemented in the Doornfontein area, crime has dropped by more than 40% and multiple arrests have been made.




