Walking and Socialising

Dear residents,

I shared your joy at the lifting of ELV's walking regulations but I want to issue a personal word of caution and an appeal.

Frankly, I was appalled at the blatant disregard I observed and had reported to me about the behaviour of many residents during the 'Appreciation' time at 5 pm last night, minutes after Wilma's circular went out.

ELV management does not have the authority to overrule national regulations. The key phrase in that circular was: '...you may do so entirely at your own risk!'

Just days before, Wilma had received complaints from neighbours about the vuvuzelas and the socialising during the 5 pm 'Appreciation' time. I have little doubt that those same or other neighbours would alert the police if such blatant disregard continued. And there are many reports of the police entering gated communities to arrest residents who were disregarding the national regulations, so do not believe that is not possible.

So my appeal: please treat ELV's concessions responsibly and don't give any neighbour cause to alert the police! Please, carefully read management's regulations again and observe them!
