We are delighted to have Mary Ann Brews (#78) return to the Village after her recent back surgery.

Mary Ann was going to go into frail care for a week from Bryanston step down but unfortunately tested positive for COVID19 when her test results were received this morning. Due to this she can not go into Frail care and she has returned to her unit and we have arranged a stay in carer to care for her over the next 14 days as she has to isolate.

Please welcome her back and send her messages of support via Whatsapp or email. But please do not go and visit or pop in yet. Should you want to take her something, please leave it outside the door and ring the bell. Portia the Care worker will then collect and give to her.

I am delighted to inform you that the other resident that we have that tested positive for COVID19 is doing better. Still in hospital but being moved to a general ward today out of high care.

We have also been contacted by Clicks at Broadacres this morning after their delivery to the Village. They have had their Sister test positive for Covid19 and have had to send all the staff home to isolate for 14 days. They will sanitize the pharmacy over night and will have stand in staff on duty from tomorrow. Due to this they will not be able to deliver to the Village until the 5<sup>th</sup> of August 2020. The pharmacy will be open but just can't deliver.
