Hospitality Portfolio

Dear Residents,

I am happy to report that a resident has volunteered to lead the Hospitality portfolio, but more of that later. Before that, your ResCom had made the following decisions to make things easier for the portfolio leader:

- To split the portfolio into 3 sections:
- o <u>Activities and outings:</u> this will be split into two sub-sections:

Activities: to arrange activities that can normally not be arranged by individual residents, e.g.: the Xmas market, Boule, croquet, street braais, etc.

Outings: to theatres, concerts, places of interest, e.g.: Walter Sisulu Botanical Gardens, the Buddhist temple in Bronkhorstspruit, etc.

- o <u>Meet and greet:</u> teams of residents to meet, greet, and direct residents arriving in the Bistro for social dinners and functions to their tables.
- o <u>Functions:</u> This section will be responsible for organizing special Bistro-based celebrations such as Burns night, St. Patrick's Day, Xmas in July etc.
- To discuss these proposals with all the people who had previously led the Hospitality portfolio to get the benefit of their experience.
