IMPORTANT SELF ISOLATION COVID19

I am sure like me; you have been watching the sharp rise in the infection rate over the past 7 days closely. Yesterday we breached the ten thousand mark for new

With the second wave of COVID-19 now a reality we once again want to remind residents about the importance of self-isolation.

If you or your spouse have been in contact with someone that is COVID-19 positive, you need to self-isolate in your home for a minimum of 10 days. Please inform Village Management in order for us to keep a record and also to ensure that we can check up on you daily and assist with any arrangements you might need. We would also like to advise residents when there are any residents that are self-isolating so that they are aware and they don't come knocking on your door. We will gladly assist with a laminated sign that can be put on your front door or front gate to alert residents that you are in self-isolation.

It is a stark reminder that Covid-19 is everywhere and we should take every precaution, we must be vigilant. Please ensure that you wear a three-ply cloth mask **over your nose and mouth** at all times when leaving your home; wash your hands and sanitise every hour on the hour; practice social distancing of at least two meters.

We would again like to reiterate to all residents to please alert the Village Manager as soon as you experience any COVID-19 symptoms, such as a sore throat; a fever or increased temperature; a dry cough; body aches; or shortness of breath; loss of taste and/or smell. If you suspect that you have coronavirus symptoms, please call the clinic or reception for assistance – please do not come to the clubhouse. It is vital that you report to Village Management as soon as you are not feeling well and that you isolate and do not socialise with other residents.

Furthermore, should you or any of your family go for a COVID-19 test, we request that you inform us immediately. Please do not let them visit you until they receive a negative result and we have been informed.
