POSTPONEMENT OF AGM to 10 JUNE 2021.

We are extremely proud of the fact that as a Group we have been able to have all our Evergreen Villages vaccinated in the past 3 weeks.

With the 3rd wave in Gauteng, we have seen huge increases in Covid numbers in our sector. Merrow Down has completely closed down their public areas due to the high volume of Covid numbers in their Village. We are aware of at least two other villages that have similar high positive Covid numbers.

While we have been fortunate to only have three positive cases in our Village so far, we need to be very careful of not letting our guard down this far into the race against this Virus.

Having carefully considered that Garry Reed and his team in Cape Town have been actively involved in the vaccination process at the 5 Villages in Cape Town, and thus exposed to 1000 residents from all over Cape Town, it was decided that it would be irresponsible to expect him and his team to now travel to Gauteng to have our AGM at which we will now have to limit numbers to only 80 residents who can attend.

So, in order to prevent this risk to Garry and his team as well as to our residents, it has been decided to postpone the AGM to 12 August 2021; when hopefully we have past the 3rd wave and we have all had our 2nd vaccinations. We will then also hopefully be on a different lock down level and will be able to have more residents at the AGM and at the social after the AGM.

We apologise for the inconvenience but trust that you will agree with our decision to put our Staff and resident's health first.

We look forward to seeing you all at the AGM.
