

The annual Heritage Day Street Braai will take place on: Friday the 24th of September 2021 at 16:00.



NATIONAL PANCAKE DAY

National Pancake Day on September 26th sets up a tall stack of syrupy goodness to celebrate! Set the table. Mix up the batter. Heat up the griddle.

It became a traditional part of Fat Tuesday (Shrove Tuesday) celebrations when revellers would feast before fasting. They still do! The thin cakes can be rolled and filled with fruit and other fillings. Usually, though, they're stacked and drizzled with flavoured syrup.

Add fruit, nuts or whipped topping, too. While served mostly as a breakfast item, pancakes along with bacon, ham, hash browns and other morning offerings also make a delicious supper. Breakfast for dinner is a nice change of pace in many homes.

A pancake is a flat cake, often thin and round, prepared from a starch-based batter that may contain eggs, milk and butter and cooked on a hot surface such as a griddle or frying pan, often frying with oil or butter. Archaeological evidence suggests that pancakes were probably the earliest and most widespread cereal food eaten in prehistoric societies.
