UPDATE COVID-19

Herewith correspondence notifying you of Covid19 arrangements which require clarification, due to recent National Department of Health circulars being retracted, as reported in the media.

We have cases of the Omicron variant in the villages currently and urge residents to take care. We are keeping in constant communication with residents affected and wish them all a speedy recovery. Evergreen Health has continued to do close contact tracing and tested those with symptoms.

Please be aware of the personal risk assessment and keep an eye out for symptoms. A high-risk exposure constitutes sitting for more than 15 minutes, less than 1.5 metres close to someone whom tested positive for Covid19, without wearing a mask.

The current common **symptoms** of Covid19 include any flu-like symptoms such as body aches, a cough, sore/ scratchy throat, temperature above 37,3 degrees Celsius and extreme tiredness. Other symptoms include loss of smell or taste, and as well as nausea, vomiting or diarrhea.

Evergreen Health can assist with Covid19 rapid antigen or PCR tests for your account as required.

Quarantine: If you are a close contact of someone with Covid19, a quarantine of staying at home 10 days after such exposure is required, with no socialization.

Isolation: If you have Covid19, an isolation period of staying at home for 10 days after symptoms started is required, with no socialization.

Please contact Evergreen Health if you require any support with Covid19 symptoms and village management for other support needs.

Vaccination Boosters

Evergreen Health is negotiating with local health authorities to get vaccine stock by 18 January 2022 and each village will be notified of the booster vaccine roll out dates. Immunocompromised individuals will be vaccinated on these days too. Contact Evergreen Health if you have queries.
