Dear Residents,

### **Booster Vaccinations.**

We have been able to secure booster vaccinations from the Gauteng Department of Health.

Since we only have Sister Marius that can administer the vaccinations, we will have to administer these boosters over a three-day period. Being 19 – 21 January 2022 as detailed below.

You need to be eligible for a booster shot on the EVDS system in order for us to administrate the booster vaccine to you. Therefore, if we go into the system and it does not show you as eligible, we will not be able to give you the booster.

IF you had Covid 19 recently you will only be eligible for the booster shot 40 days after your positive test. If you have tested positive in the past 40 days the system will not allow you to get the booster shot until 40 days have passed.

We will only be administering booster shots to residents, so please do not invite friends, family or helpers to join you for the booster shot.

Please make your way down to reception during your allocated time slot. You will be required to provide your ID number in order for us to access the EVDS system to see if you are eligible for the booster shot.

Once the system shows that you are eligible, we can capture the booster information and provide you with a number that must be documented on your vaccination card. Thus, we ask that you bring your vaccination card with you or alternatively your vaccination certificate. If you have already printed your vaccination certificate, you will be required to make use of the same process after the booster shot to get an updated certificate that shows the details of your booster shot as well. In the event that you have misplaced your vaccination card or certificate, please contact us prior to your time slot in order to assist you so that you are not holding up the flow of the process on vaccination days.

Should your allocated time slot not suit you, you are welcome to slot into a slot that better suits you without contacting us. We will try and accommodate residents as they arrive.

Please ensure you wear a mask, and keep appropriate social distancing when coming down to the Lifestyle Centre for your booster shot.
