Sewerage line blockages:

Last week we once again had a blocked sewerage line at the bottom of the village where the sewerage pipe runs between house 70 and the Jojo tanks.

This is the third incident this year. Every time we have to get a plumber out to bring their coils to open the blocked line for us. And every time the blockage was caused by a diaper that was flushed down a toilet.

Please can I ask that under no circumstances do you ever flush a nappy down a toilet. Please also ensure that any carers you have working for you in your unit are aware not to do this. Evergreen Health provides a nappy collection service at R25 and these nappies then get discarded through Initial Health as medical waste as it should be.

Not only does it cost the village money to call out a plumber every time, but it is also unpleasant to have a sewerage leak in plain sight and smell of residents in the village.

Please may I ask for everybody's cooperation in this regard.
