## Speeding and cutting of corner at Heron and Loerie Lane:

As part of our ongoing endeavours to reduce speeding and the cutting of the corners of especially Loerie and Heron road, we have placed temporary curbing at each of the 3 stop signs at this intersection. This will force all road users to stick to the correct lane and will hopefully prevent them from cutting the corner and potentially putting pedestrians at risk.

We have painted these temporary curbing yellow and put reflective tape on them as well to ensure they are visible during the day and during the night.

Please look out for these and drive slowly. We will monitor their effectiveness over the next few weeks before making a decision on whether or not to put up permanent curbing.
