YOUTH DAY

Youth Day commemorates the Soweto youth uprising of 16 June 1976. This uprising spread countrywide profoundly changed the socio-political landscape in South Africa. Events that triggered the uprising can be traced back to policies of the Apartheid government that resulted in the introduction of the Bantu Education Act in 1953.

The march was meant to culminate at a rally in Orlando Stadium. On their pathway, they were met by heavily armed police who fired teargas and later live ammunition on demonstrating students. This resulted in a widespread revolt that turned into an uprising against the government. While the uprising began in Soweto, it spread across the country and carried on until the following year.

This year marks the 47th anniversary of the 16 June 1976 student uprising in Soweto when young people protested against imposition of Afrikaans by the apartheid regime as a medium of instruction. The uprising ended tragically with hundreds of young people being brutally killed.

The call to action in 2023 is to promote sustainable livelihoods and resilience of young people for a better tomorrow.



FATHER'S DAY
