# JOHANNESBURG WATER NOTICE OF WATER INTERUPTION:

There is a planned shutdown to effect repairs to a main supply line on the 27<sup>th</sup> of July 2023 from 08:00 – 16:00.

Kengies is one of the affected areas with Frederick Road being specifically mentioned. This means that the Village will be without water for this period. Please ensure you will up your kettles and water bottles in anticipation of this 8 hours without water.

Please take care not to use all the water in the geyser during this period or letting your geyser run empty. This can result in the element burning if the geyser runs dry. Should you use the water in the geyser, please switch off the geyser until such time as the water has been restored and you are sure your geyser has filled up. It will then be safe to switch the geyser on again. Should you be unsure of how to go about switching your geyser off, please feel free to contact Marius Viljoen who will assist you.

Water will be available at the clubhouse for anybody who needs to collect.
