Arbor Day 7 September 2024

A reminder that next Saturday, 7 September, is Arbor Day!

We based our planning on this amount and planned to plant 3 trees. Two late donations have been received. R1 000 generously donated by The Waterhole management. Thank you, Val Diesel, for your generous donation of a tree that will increase the number to be planted to 4.

Thanks, are also due to Hennie Du Preez and the Gardening committee for organizing and running this initiative. Appreciation to Evergreen management for preparing the holes and for providing compost.

So far, 2 ladies and 1 gentleman have volunteered to help with the planting. So, come-on you able bodied men, surely you can do better than that! We will require 2 teams of 4 – 5 residents each. In addition, there will be at least 1 gardener to help each team with the heavy lifting.
