Please note: Evergreen Broadacres operates in the non-acute arena, offering **Frail Care** and **Home Care** services to meet long-term care and home-based care needs.

1. Acute Care (Hospital Care)

Purpose: For surgery, emergency and critical medical situations.

- Location: Hospitals.
- **Type of Care**: Intensive, short-term care for severe or sudden medical conditions such as surgeries, heart attacks, strokes, or accidents.
- **Goal**: Stabilize patients and treat life-threatening conditions.
- **Duration**: Temporary, until the patient is stable enough to be discharged or transferred to a lower level of care.

2. Sub-Acute Care (Rehabilitation or Step-Down Care)

Purpose: Recovery and rehabilitation after a hospital stay.

- Location: Specialized facilities or care centres.
- **Type of Care**: For patients who no longer need hospital-level acute care but still require medical supervision.
- **Services**: Includes physical therapy, wound care, pain management, IV therapy, and other rehabilitation services.
- **Goal**: To help patients regain independence or transition to a more permanent care setting.
- **Duration**: Short to medium-term, depending on recovery progress.

3. Non-Acute Care (Frail Care) - Provided by Evergreen

Purpose: Long-term support for those with ongoing care needs.

- Location: Frail care units within Evergreen's facilities.
- Type of Care: For individuals with chronic illnesses, disabilities, or those needing constant assistance with daily activities like dressing, eating, and mobility.



- **Services**: Full-time care, including personal assistance, monitoring, and medical care as required.
- Goal: To provide comfort and maintain quality of life in a safe and caring environment.
- **Duration**: Long-term, as required by the resident's condition.

4. Home Care - Provided by Evergreen

Purpose: Personal care and assistance provided at home.

- Location: Your own residence.
- **Type of Care**: For residents who prefer to stay at home but need some level of care.
- **Services**: Ranges from help with daily tasks (like bathing, dressing, and meal prep) to medical services such as medication management or nursing care.
- **Goal**: To support independence while providing necessary care in the comfort of your own home.
- **Duration**: Flexible, ranging from a few hours a week to full-time care.
