Resident Notification on Second Pfizer Vaccination - COVID 19

We are delighted to inform you that the second Pfizer Vaccination for Covid-19 will take place at Evergreen Diep River in the Recreation Room on the Friday, 16th July 2021. Staff Nurse Sharon Adams will start setting up bookings with each resident from Monday, similarly to the way we did it in the 1st round.

Most of you would have received an SMS confirming your first vaccination and perhaps you might have received a notification from the EVDS system about locations for available sites where you can get your second vaccine.

You can go to any of these sites with your vaccination card to get your second vaccine administered, or you can wait till the **Friday, 16th July** and have it done at the Diep River Village.

We have all the vaccination cards from your first vaccination and will complete these cards with your second vaccination information and hand them over to you on the day.

When you come down to the Recreation Room at your arranged and designated time to be vaccinated, we will work on the EVDS database to process vaccinations. Please note residents will come down and register at the table as per the last time. You will then be directed to receive your second vaccine. Once you have received your vaccine, you will stay in the observation area for approximately 15 minutes to see if you have any adverse effects or reactions. A paramedic will be on site to tend to any person who might experience adverse reactions.


Please bear in mind that if you've had your flu or pneumonia vaccine in the 30 days leading up to Friday, 16 July 2021 you cannot be vaccinated. You can also not go for a flu or pneumonia vaccine in the 30 days after receiving your COVID19 vaccine.

If you have recently been tested positive for COVID19, you will have to wait 30 days after your 14-day recovery period before you can get your second vaccine. Unfortunately, we cannot keep vaccines for residents who cannot make this vaccination date.

We will send out communication early next week to set appointment times for residents to make their way down to the Recreation room so that we have a smooth flow of residents coming through to vaccinated, in order to reduce delay or waiting times.
