The Norval Foundation is a centre for art and cultural expression. They are dedicated to the research and exhibition of 20th- and 21st-century visual art from South Africa and beyond. It is located in the Steenberg area of Cape Town, adjacent to Table Mountain National Park, the Norval Foundation combines the experience of art with an appreciation for nature.

Their Sculpture Garden, outdoor amphitheatre, purpose-built exhibition spaces and research library are situated in a unique setting that offers visitors a multisensory experience. This is complemented by the Skotnes Restaurant and Bar, a bespoke shop and a children's playground.
