


The Thursday Knitting Club

In this Met Opera version of Rossini's comic opera The Italian Girl in Algiers (L'Italiana in Algeri), the headstrong and clever Italian woman Isabella (Marilyn

Horne) arrives in Algiers to rescue her beloved Lindoro (Douglas Ahlstedt), who has been enslaved by the powerful and eccentric Bey of Algiers, Mustafa (Paolo Montarsolo). Bored with his wife and seeking a more spirited companion, Mustafa becomes enamoured with Isabella, unaware of her true intentions. With quick wit and charm, Isabella manages to manipulate the Bey and turn his court upside down, all while scheming to free Lindoro and the other Italian captives.

As the opera unfolds, Isabella outsmarts everyone around her, orchestrating a plan that ultimately leads to her triumphant escape with Lindoro. Mustafa, thoroughly outwitted and humbled, resigns himself to

his marriage and praises the cleverness of Italian women. Filled with lively ensembles, rapid-fire vocal fireworks, and humorous misunderstandings, Rossini's opera delivers a spirited tale of female empowerment, resilience, and wit, wrapped in exuberant music and comic flair.
