A hyperlink is a bit of text, an image, or a button that you can click that will take you to the right page or to the information that you're looking for.

Why would this help me?

It's a faster and more efficient way to scroll through our Aloe Aloe Newsletter. For instance, if you wanted to see what resident events we have but don't want to scroll through 10 pages, the hyperlink would take you straight there from the contents page.


It stars Edward Woodward as the title character, Lt. Harry Harbord




