Our very own Lizzy who has found a home at the beautiful garden pots outside the Lifestyle Centre. There are many in the village. Please drive carefully.





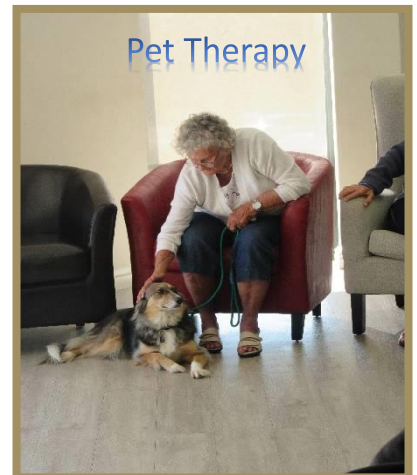

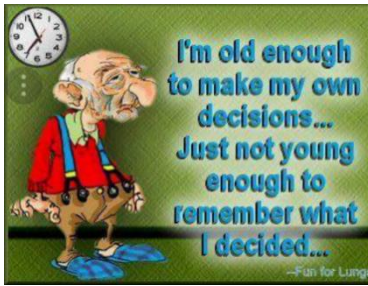
