TEACHER : Name the nation people hate most

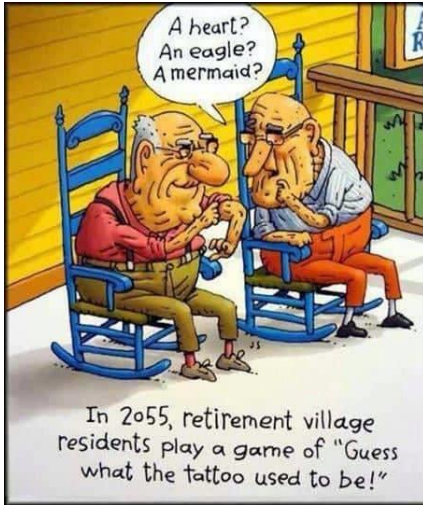
Student: Exami-nation...

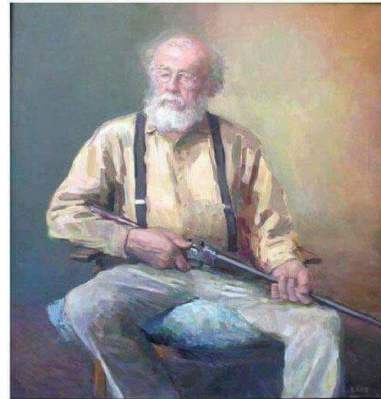
The lawyer was stunned! Not knowing what else to do, he pointed across the room and asked, "Mrs. Jones, do you know the defence attorney?"
