AFFECTED AREAS:

South of the N2 reaching from Strand in the East through Khayelitsha, Mitchells Plain, Philippi to Plumstead and down into the Southern suburbs as far as about Muizenburg.

ADVICE - do one of these:

- Boil water for a minute, let it cool down and store in clean, sealed containers. OR...
- Add at 2 drops of (unperfumed) liquid household bleach to every 1 litre of water, and let it stand for 30 minutes before use. If water is cloudy, add 4 drops per 1 litre.
