After meeting with a concerned resident, and hearing both sides of the story, the decision for the distribution of funds to include the Bistro staff, has been made, despite the valid objections and complaints to the levels of service of the many residents who have approached RESCOM in writing and in meetings.

METHOD OF DISTRIBUTION

The historic and current method of distribution of the total of funds is as follows: The total money donation is divided between the total number of Evergreen Muizenberg Village Staff, and based on the following criteria:

- Less than a full 12-month service, pro rata rate is paid
- Sub contractors, e.g.

White Cliffs - Gardens

Grinnell - Security

Laundry - Cleaning Services Fedics - Catering/The Bistro

Please note that Management, in all of the departments (including sub-contractors) are excluded.

After my discussion with Garry Reed (MD Evergreen Lifestyle Villages) and as per the House Rules, clause 4.4.2 Life Right Holders are requested to refrain from giving gifts, making loans to and/or tipping Evergreen staff, including contractors on site, as in line with the Owner and the Operator's gifting policy Village staff are not allowed to accept such gifts/tips/loans as it will result in a breach of their employment agreements with the Owner/Operator. Christmas gifts (where applicable) must be coordinated by the Village Manager.

Your understanding and co-operation is important to the successful operation of this village.
