4.	Finance and Statistics

	to the benefit of the residents. The Resident's Fund remains at R6060.00

	The total of residents for were 301 down form a high of 313 in March.		
	Unoccupied houses 5 and apartments 15.		
	With new residents due to arrive in the weeks to come.		
5.	Repairs and Maintenance		
	RG reported on Building Redecoration and Waterproofing.		
	We are now six weeks into the project, and we are pleased to report that all remedial		
	work has been completed without any unexpected issues. The waterproofing of the		
	first section of the roof is close to completion. While progress has varied from week to		
	week - mainly due to the weather - we are steadily moving forward and remain		
	committed to keeping you informed as we go.		

	The pool needs to be relined, and plans are being prepared to have it done as soon	
	as possible.	
6.	Gardens

	RG responded to the requests in the report, that it would depend on the availability of	
	budgeted funds at the time.	
	An audit of the sprinkler system is in the process of being carried out with repairs to	
	follow. Several repairs are required on sprinklers next to driveways where residents	
	drive over them. This cannot remain a cost to the village and the procedure to allocate	
	these charges to residents in question will be shared once finalised.

	There are no security issues to report.	
	The security site supervisors and shift leaders have been sent on First Aid and Fire	
	training courses.
