RESCOM - July Maintenance report.

- 1. Roof repairs to main building still in progress, together with remedial work to the front of the building.
- 2. Normal refurbishment of vacant houses and apartments continues as required.
- 3. A water leak from an overhead pipeline opposite parking bay No. 5 has been reported
- 4. The re-siting of the water collection tank, off the boardwalk, in the wetland area was successfully completed and appropriate replanting well done.
- 5. The renovation of the swimming pool and painting of the GYM are complete.
- 6. Road marking paintwork throughout the village has been redone.
- 7. Redecorating of the apartment corridor walls is scheduled for later in the year.

Notes for incoming year:

- 1. Repainting of the basement parking floor area is becoming necessary.
- 2. Forward planning for the solar heating of apartment water should commence. This will provide huge savings in the present cost of water heating and the ever-increasing cost of electricity, whilst the roof area remains unused.
