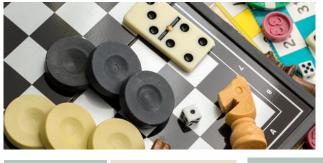

This year we are again calling upon our residents to be involved in this wonderful charity event.

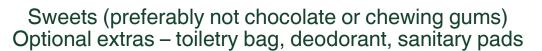
How it works:
