- 1. Copy of the BCEA Act (Summary Charts)
- 2. Copies of the Attendance Register for the period of 3 months for 2 employees.
- 3. 2 Copies of signed contracts of employment
- 4. 2 Copies of information about remuneration (Pay slips) for 2 different employees.
- 5. Unemployment Insurance registration number and a copy of proof of last payment
- Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act (COIDA)Registration number and the copy of last payment or a Letter of Good Standing
- 7. A copy of a CIPRO Certificate
- 8. A copy of the Letter Head
- 9. A list containing names and ID Numbers of all the employees in the branch.
- 10.If deducting for Pension / Provident Fund proof of last payment to the fund

## NB: ALL THE REQUIRED INSPECTION DOCUMENTS MUST BE HANDED OVER TO AN INSPECTOR DURING THE PHYSICAL INSPECTION ON THE DAY OF INSPECTION. ALTERNATIVE ARRANGEMENT MAY BE MADE WITH THE INSPECTOR CONDUCTING THE INSPECTION THEREOF.
