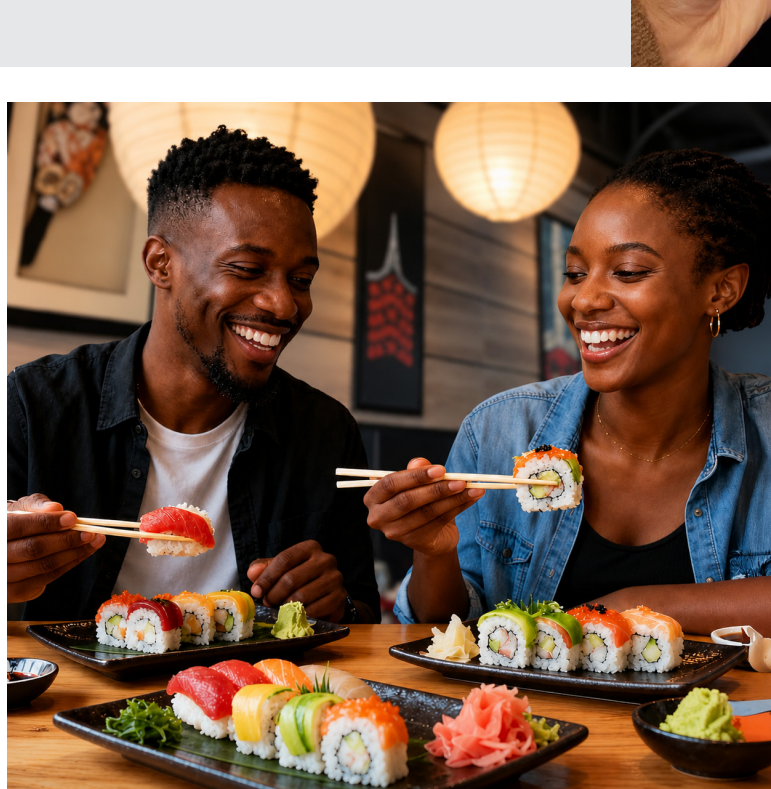
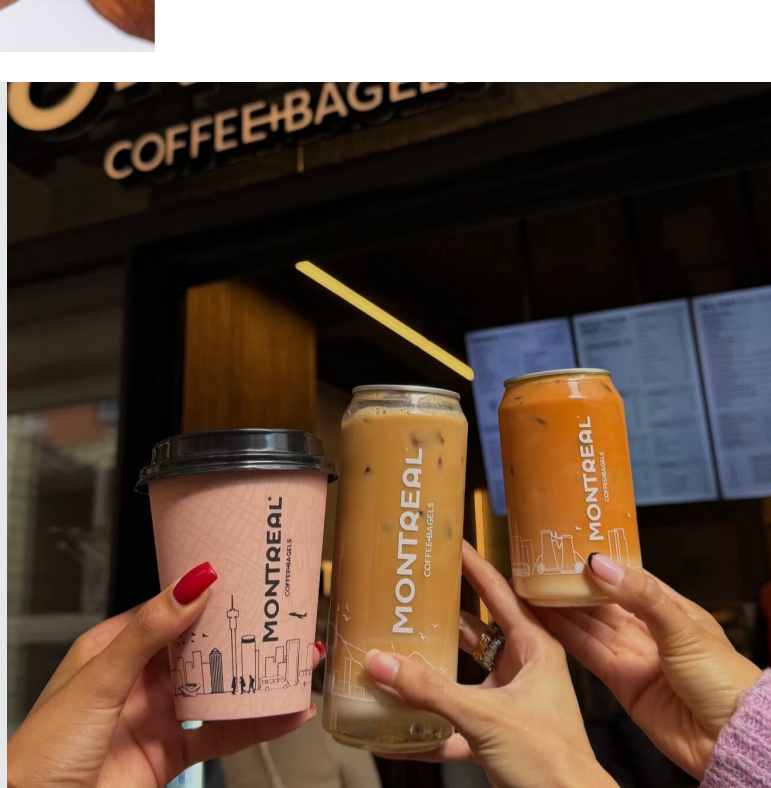


NICOLE'S MACAROONS

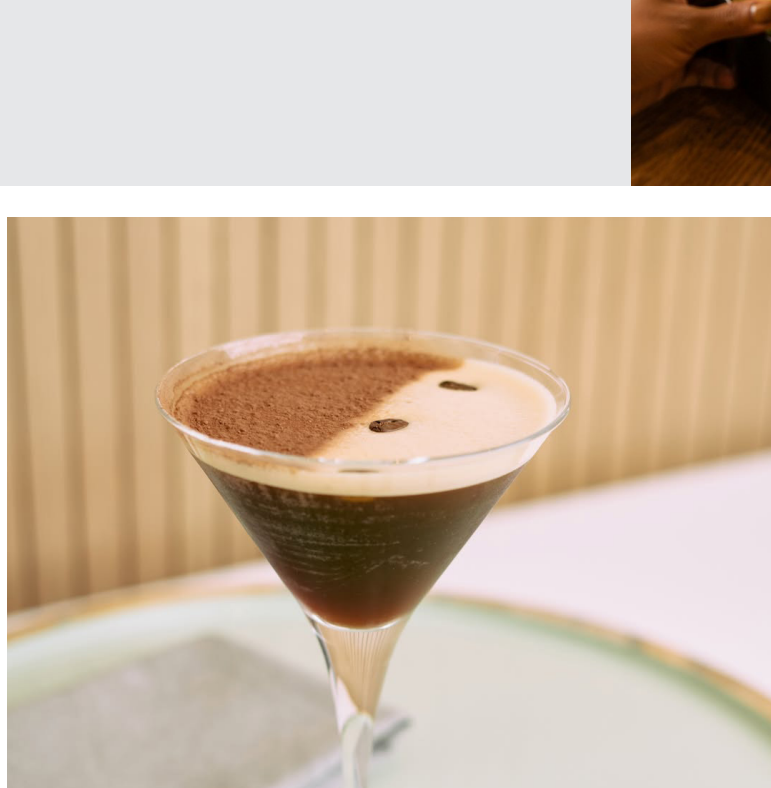


YAMATO
